Katherine Seals is the Program Evaluator for the Healthy Communities CDC High Obesity Program (HOP) at the Louisiana State University (LSU) AgCenter. She holds a bachelor's degree in biological sciences from LSU, a master's in public health from the LSU Health Sciences Center in New Orleans, and a master's in sociology from LSU. Katherine specializes in evaluating multi-level, community-driven approaches to implementing Policy, Systems, and Environmental (PSE) change strategies. Her work primarily focuses on promoting local rural food systems and active transportation among rural Louisiana residents. From 2019 to 2023, Katherine evaluated six grant communities, collecting both qualitative and quantitative data to demonstrate the impacts of the Healthy Communities program. Since 2023, the program has expanded to 12 parishes. In her current role, Katherine collaborates closely with Cooperative Extension agents to collect formative, process, and impact data, thereby providing a robust evidence base for program interventions.
